GALLOWAY TWP. – Richard Stockton College of New Jersey Faculty members will have the opportunity to engage in new technologies for teaching and learning through a “Summer Tech Academy” to take place next year, announced at today’s meeting of the Board of Trustees.

The Academy will run for two weeks from June 18 to June 28, 2007. Faculty will work individually and in small teams on a multimedia or web project that addresses an instructional problem, enhances existing courses or creates a new course. The academy will be open to 20 faculty members who will receive a \$2,000 stipend upon completion of the program.
